

SULTAN

Diploid annual ryegrass

- Fast establishing diploid annual
- Offers a lower sowing cost for higher winter feed and carrying capacity
- Mid-season maturity
- Very high yielding
- Strong autumn/ winter/ spring activity with excellent palatability
- Good leaf retention well into heading
- Bred with broad disease tolerance

The majority of annual ryegrasses are tetraploids, requiring a much higher sowing rate than Sultan. This can typically be between 25-30 Kg/ha for a tetraploid, compared to 18 Kg/ha Sultan.
