Subterranean clover

- Subspecies ssp.yannanicum
- Mid - late season maturity
- Great for dryland permanent pasture
- Ideal companion with Greenly II
- Combine with other subterranean cultivars
- Suited to soils prone to waterlogging or higher annual rainfall
- Moderate levels of hardseededness to help protect against seedling losses with false breaks

Option for soils prone to waterlogging or higher annual rainfall. Graze until flowering and then reduce stocking rate to promote seed set

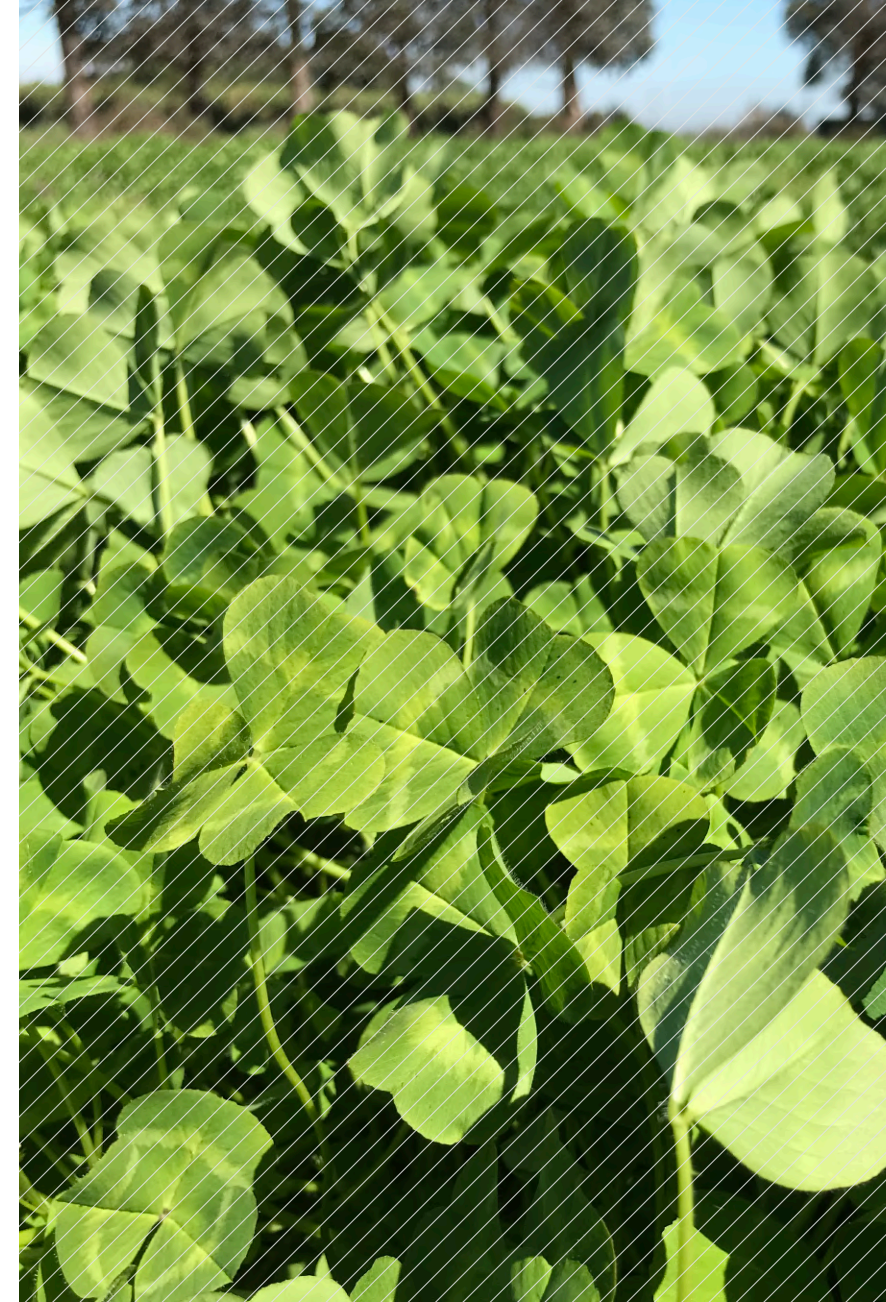
